

I don't think I'm going to get to all 1001 wines before I die. But this book will help me choose the ones I do get to. Filled with great photos, lots of history, and all the facts you want to know about wine, this is an excellent book for both novices and knowledgable wine drinkers.

It's a good book of very different wines. Some are inexpensive some ultra expensive. The really nice thing is that it highlighted wineries that have other less expensive wines that I could try. It's a fun coffee table book.

Over the years I've collected many books on wine (having been in the Wine Trade for a long time). Now retired I can re-read and buy new ones. This book is thick and heavy, but contains all you need to know about not only the 1001 wines in it, but also the vineyard, history, proprietor, winemaker and how the wine was made. Most importantly it tells you what it tastes like, and recommends other vintages of the same wine and also recommends other wines similar in style and price. And there are lots of photos either of the vineyard, estate or product. It does refer mainly to high end and expensivewines but does contain details of many, many affordable wines. Written in a non-technical style, it is not only very readable, but a must have reference book. Enjoy the book and the wines in it!
