<p>Vodka Unlike its unassuming, colorless, odorless alcohol distillate, vodka's flavor comes from grain that pass through charcoal. In Russia, the word <i>vodka</i> is derived from the word "wodka," or water.</p> <p>BLACK RUBINIAN 1 1/2 oz coffee liqueur Fill old-fashioned glass with ice cubes. Add ingredients and stir.</p> <p>VARIATIONS Sambuca - use cognac for the vodka. Black Line - use 1/2 oz coffee liqueur and 3/4 oz raspberry liqueur with the vodka. White Russian - add 1 oz cream. Sheridan - a White Russian with a splash of vanilla ice cream instead of cream. Black Forest - White Russian with 1/2 oz black raspberry liqueur added before the cream. Green Russian - use crème de menthe instead of the coffee liqueur. Red Russian - use a cherry liqueur instead of the coffee liqueur. Mudslide - White or Black Russian with 1 oz Irish cream added.</p> <p>CAPE CODDER 2 oz vodka 1/2 oz cranberry juice Pour vodka over ice in large old-fashioned glass. Fill with cranberry juice and top with lemon.</p> <p>VARIATIONS Screwdriver - use orange juice for the cranberry. Guy Fieri's - use grapefruit juice for the cranberry. Salty Dog - just use 1/2 glass with lime and salt. Fill with ice and a Crystal Ball.</p> <p>MORE VARIATIONS In the following variations, start with a Cape Codder and add the ingredients, pour, and half with the listed juice. Red Berry - raspberries Doncaster - pineapple Sea Breeze - grapefruit Mudras - orange Flying Mudras - orange, blue champagne to fill with glass</p>	<p>Multi-Mixers</p> <p>LONG ISLAND ICED TEA 1/2 oz vodka 1/2 oz rum 1/2 oz gin 1/2 oz tequila 1/2 oz triple sec 1 oz sour mix 1/2 oz lime 1/2 oz cola</p> <p>Put all over ice in tall glass and top off with cola. Garnish with lemon.</p> <p>VARIATIONS Long Island Lemonade - replace cola with lemon-lime soda. Long Beach Iced Tea - replace sour mix with orange juice and fill with equal parts cranberry juice and sour mix.</p> <p>BLOODY MARY 2 oz vodka 1/2 tsp horseradish dash hot pepper sauce dash Worcestershire sauce dash lime juice dash celery seed (optional) dash ground pepper dash salt 1/2 tsp tomato juice*</p> <p>Mix all in glass with ice cubes or combine in cocktail shaker to best results. Garnish with lemon wedge and/or celery stalk. *Use Vegetable Juice™ in a popular alternative. There are over a dozen commercially prepared mixes available.</p> <p>VARIATIONS Bloody Bull - add 1 oz beef broth or top instead of tomato juice. Bloody Caesar - fill with equal parts of clam and tomato juice. In the following, use <i>equal</i> parts of each of the vodka. Bloody Maria - use rum. Bloody Martha - use rum. Bloody Shady - use whiskey. Bloody Jeopardy - use scotch.</p> <p><small>*The American Council on Agricultural Information of the Certified Food Institute</small></p>	<p>Traditionally the martini is made with dry and sweet vermouth. Some people prefer only dry or only sweet. New types of sweetened "longer martinis" have evolved to include citrus and combinations of ingredients that is poured into the classic wedge-shaped martini cocktail glass.</p> <p>CLASSIC MARTINI 1 oz gin dash dry vermouth Combine liquids in mixing glass with ice and stir rapidly if you're a "stirrer" (don't). Strain into chilled martini glass. Garnish with olive.</p> <p>VARIATIONS Note: Dryness (amount of vermouth) is a complex subject. Some want a splash of vermouth mixed with the gin and others don't. The usual rule is to use 1 part gin to 1 part vermouth. Very dry may mean just pouring the gin from the vermouth bottle continuously over the glass (the "old-fashioned" way). Super dry may mean straight vodka while nicely starting at the vermouth bottle (the "Charlton" martini).</p> <p>Traditional - use ratio of 1:1 for the olive. Citrus - use a cocktail shaker for the olive. Vanilla Martini - use vodka for the gin. Sweet Martini - use sweet vermouth for the dry. Sometimes a dash of orange liqueur is added.</p>
<p>COSMOPOLITAN 1 oz vodka 1/2 oz triple sec 1/2 oz lime juice 1 oz cranberry juice Combine all with crushed ice in shaker. Strain into cocktail glass.</p> <p>FUZZY NAVEL 1 oz vodka 1 oz peach schnapps Add all over ice in highball glass and stir. Garnish with orange slice.</p> <p>KAMIKAZE 2 oz vodka 1/2 oz triple sec 1/2 oz lime juice Combine all in shaker and pour into ice old-fashioned glass.</p> <p>WHY ALCOHOL & DRUGS DON'T MIX Alcohol causes the liver to fill in 30 minutes. Alcohol affects attention and judgment abilities. Alcohol slows your reflexes and reaction times. Alcohol slows down eye reaction and the focus on the movement of approaching objects and other vehicles. Fever is judged speed and distance increases. 80% to 90% of all traffic fatalities involve alcohol. The more time to judge how much or how little to drink in after you drink. If you know you must drink, don't drink! If you know you are going to drink, let a non-driver do the driving!</p>	<p>SCORPION 1 oz light rum 1 oz tequila 1 oz white rum 1 oz triple sec 1 oz orange juice 1 oz lemon juice 1 oz amaretto</p> <p>Combine all with crushed ice in shaker. Strain into highball glass. Garnish with lemon slice.</p> <p>Tequila Tequila is made exclusively in Mexico. In order to be called tequila it must have been made from at least 100% of the juice of the Blue Agave plant and only the best 10% of the agave (and/or) must have been processed in the state of Jalisco for a 50-year government-designated period. When tequila is newly distilled, it is called "blanco" (meaning it is unaged). It is aged in oak barrels for up to one year. The most aged tequila, but for the same reasons, is called "the black." A superior tequila is obtained, which may be made from a variety of agave plants, in a variety of regions and may contain other additives.</p> <p>TEQUILA SUNRISE 2 oz tequila 2 oz orange juice 2 oz grenadine</p> <p>Combine all with ice in shaker. Strain into cocktail glass.</p> <p>VARIATIONS Many southwestern drink variations of long-established concoctions have surfaced, such as Bloody Mary, Martinis, Collins, Fizz, Sour, Stinger and more. Many substitute tequila for vodka, orange juice for gin, and a tequila substitute for rum.</p>	<p>Brandy Brandy is distilled from fruits and aged in wood. The most well-known is cognac, made exclusively in the Cognac district of France.</p> <p>AMBROSIA 1 oz brandy 1/2 oz triple sec 1/2 oz orange juice 1/2 oz champagne In a highball glass, add first three ingredients and fill with champagne. Garnish with a few raspberries, if available.</p> <p>STINGER 1/2 oz brandy 1/2 oz white rum or rum Combine all in glass with ice and stir. May be served over a rock.</p> <p>FOG CUTTER 1 oz brandy 1 oz rum 1 oz gin 1/2 oz triple sec dash sour mix dash orange or lemon juice 2 oz grapefruit juice 1/2 oz sweet berry Shake together first five ingredients with ice. Strain over fruit ice in highball glass. Fill with equal parts of juices. Shake slowly over top.</p> <p>MARGARITA 1 oz tequila 1 oz triple sec 1 oz lime juice 1 oz salt 1 oz lime wedge or olive</p> <p>In the classic salt Combine first three ingredients with crushed ice in shaker. Rub edge of large cocktail glass with lime and dip into salt. Shake mixture into glass. * Other additions, such as fruit juices, berries, olives or flavored liqueurs, may be substituted here. The danger margarita trays may only be supported by the quest for alternative and upgrading margaritas.</p>
