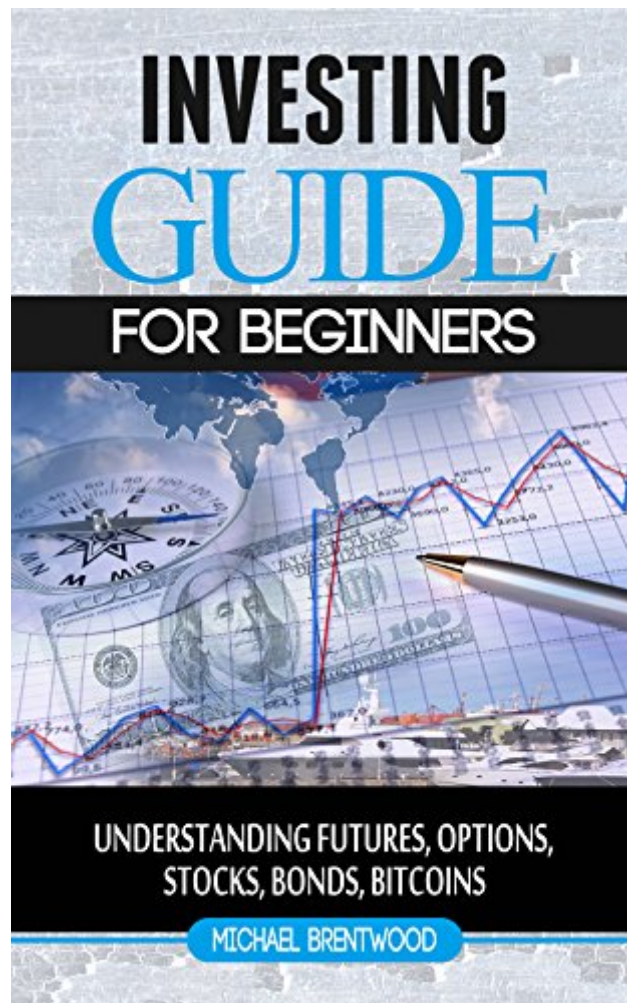

There is a lot of (I think, at least) good and solid advice for those of us who have no clue what we're doing. There's information on how to allocate funds to different types of stocks for different age groups, the difference between passive and active investors, how to keep your emotions out of investing and things like that. These are probably really basic but for someone who knows nothing on the subject, we have to start with the basics and work from there. I feel that I learned a good chunk of knowledge from this book.
