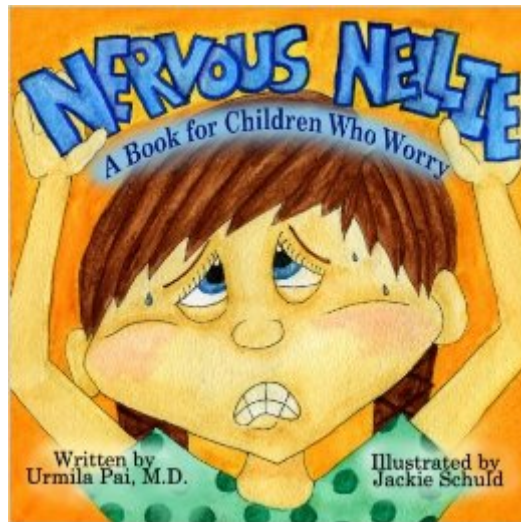

As an Educational Therapist, I work with children with Learning Disabilities, many of whom experience anxiety as an integral part of their lives. Nervous Nellie has important, yet easily understood, information for all children who live with anxiety. I believe Nervous Nellie must be read and discussed often, and over time, with young children who are either about to enter treatment or who are already in treatment.
